


Trinity Bible School will be held July 29 – August 1 from 2-6 pm, with supper being served to the kids at 5:30 pm.





Edward Richard Anderson was born at the family farm in Almond Township of Big Stone County, MN, on June 30, 1930, to Anton and Anna (Samuelson) Anderson. He was baptized and confirmed at Trinity Lutheran Church in Clinton, MN. Eddie attended country school at District #4.
